### Dick Smith Named Wiley Research Fellow

Congratulations to Richard D. Smith on being named the most recent Wiley Research Fellow. The program recognizes scientists who make significant contributions to the Department of Energy's EMSL outside of their individual research efforts. As a Research Fellow, Smith will contribute to EMSL decision-making processes, including serving on advisory committees and participating on new capability proposals. In recognition of his work, he can request time on high-demand instruments normally reserved for EMSL staff.

Smith was selected for his scientific and technological leadership in developing and applying advanced instrumentation capabilities for quantitative and high-throughput measurements of biological systems. As a Wiley Research Fellow, Smith will lead the work on the new liquid chromatography-ion mobility-time of flight mass spectrometry platforms that are being developed in the EMSL. In addition, he will continue to advance next generation measurement capabilities at EMSL. A Battelle Fellow and Chief Scientist in the Biological Sciences Division at Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, Smith is an internationally recognized scientific expert.



The Fellows program is named after William R. Wiley. A Laboratory Director at PNNL, he helped take EMSL from an idea to a world-class facility. Wiley believed that EMSL would help the world respond to scientific challenges that depended on fundamental science.
