

MONet Environmental and Regulatory Compliance process

- Applicants provide the following information at NEXUS portal:
 - Lattitude/longitude
 - Is site on federal property?
 - Is site privately owned but federally funded (LTER sites)
 - Are there existing access agreements?

2 PNNL will:

- Work with the appropriate State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) to determine if there are cultural or historical properties near the site
- Assess location for Endangered Species
- Work with applicant to utilize current project or institutional resources for compliance

- PNNL assesses if site will:
 - Require a full Review, based on NHPA section 106
 - Require a consultation based on Endangered Species Act, section 7
 - PNNL will assist with Federal, State, or private access permissions, reviews, or other documentation prior to sampling

4 MONet Project Stewards will:

 Assess applicant information along with Environmental Compliance regulatory needs prior to project approval
